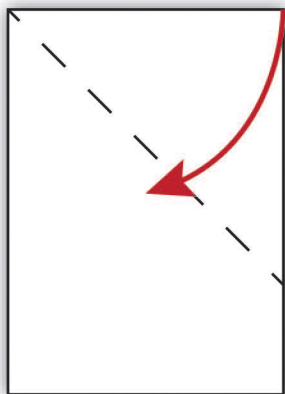
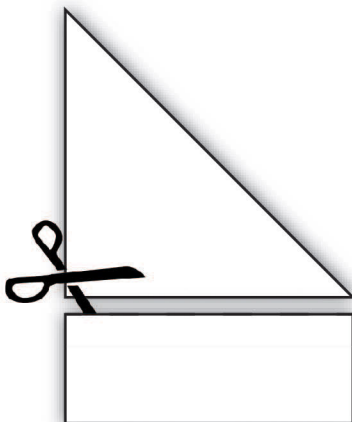


# Beluga Origami!

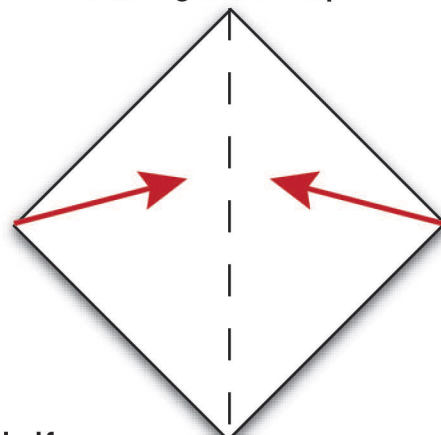
1. Make a square - take a corner and fold it down and across to the other side, making a triangle.



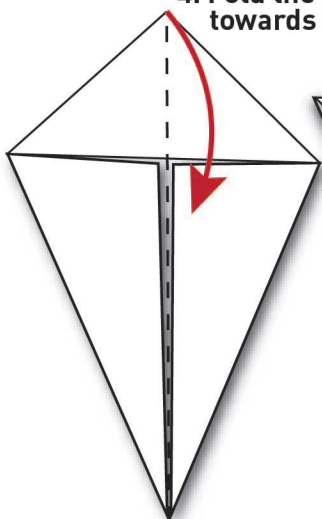
2. Cut off the extra paper and save it for another craft.



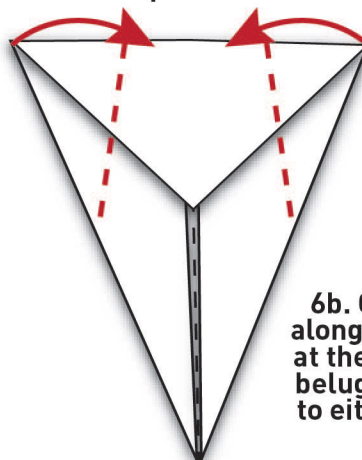
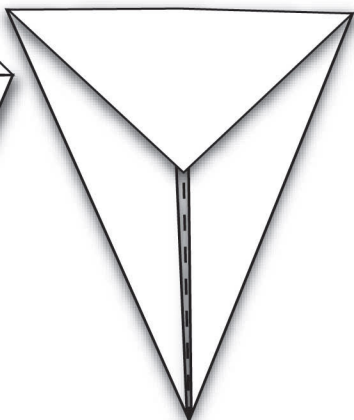
3. Lay out the paper like a diamond. Fold the bottom left and right edges to meet the line in the middle, making a kite shape.



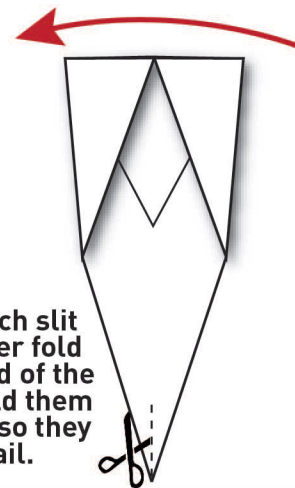
4. Fold the top part down towards the middle.



5. Fold the sides in half so that the left and right corners meet at the top of the center line.

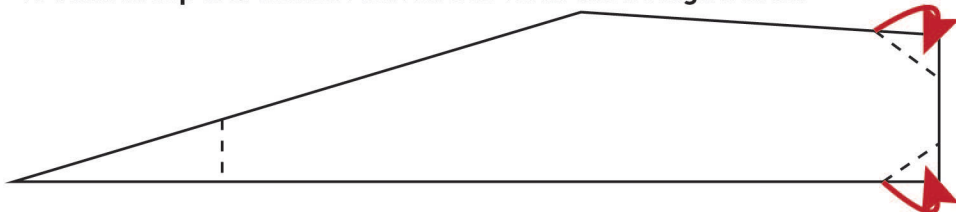


6a. Fold the piece in half.

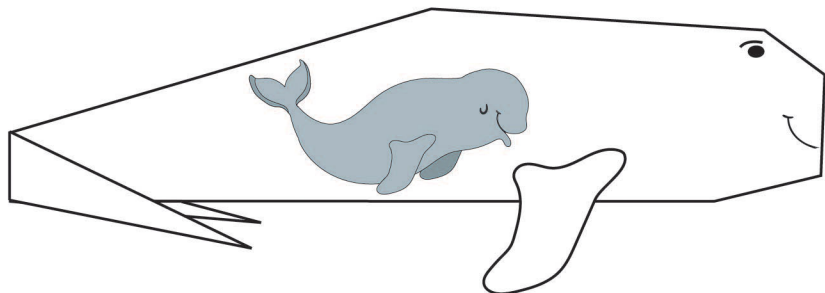


6b. Cut a 1 inch slit along the center fold at the back end of the beluga and fold them to either side so they make a tail.

7. Tuck in top and bottom corners to form the beluga's face.



8. Draw a face on your beluga and glue on the flippers and the baby beluga.



TIP: To help your beluga keep its shape, add some glue to the inside.
