The Best Butterfly Smack Bar in Toun

HOW TO MAKE THIS:

For a temporary Butterfly Snack Bar, follow the instructions on the left. If you want something that will last longer, follow the instructions on the right.

ONE-TIME USE OPTION

- Punch 3 holes around the edge of a paper plate. Spread them evenly so your plate will hang nice and flat.
- Tie a piece of string to each one of the holes.
- Tie the strings together with a knot at the top and hang it outside. Pick somewhere close to flowers.

RAINPROOF OPTION

- Make sure the plate is clean.
- Attach the plate to a base (optional).
- Place the plate and base outside in the garden or close to flowers.

Butterfly Treat Recipe

Recipe Ingredients

1 Ripe Banana

what you need:

An adult to help

Butterfly Treats (see recipe below)

and three pieces of string

Ask an adult to help you with this recipe.

1/2 Cup Dark Brown Sugar

1 Cup Water

Instructions

Mash up the banana. Put it into a saucepan and add the rest of the ingredients. Bring the mixture to a gentle simmer, making sure to stir every couple of minutes. When the mixture becomes sticky, but still runny, remove it from the heat and let it cool.

- When your Butterfly Treat mixture has cooled, spoon some onto the plate.
- Add some cut fruit or fresh flowers to the plate. This will help attract butterflies (optional).
- Wait for the butterflies to arrive!
