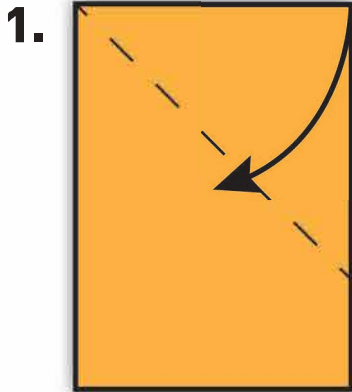


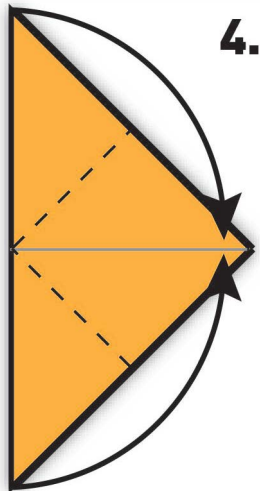


Fox Origami

Make a square - take a corner and fold it down and across to the other side, making a triangle.



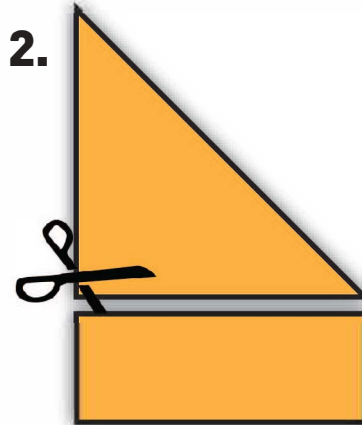
Fold the top and bottom corners across to the center.



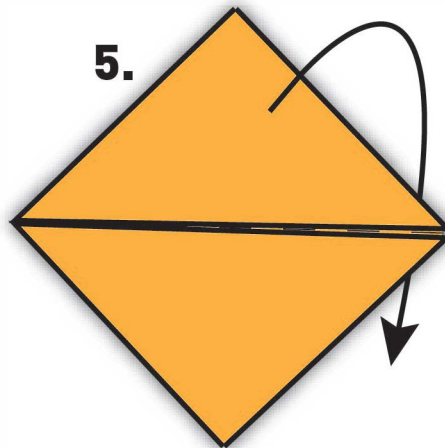
Open the center edges and fold the top down so it makes a diamond



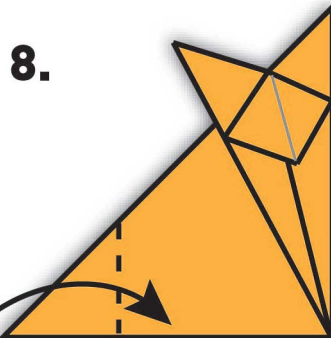
Cut off the extra paper and save it for another craft.



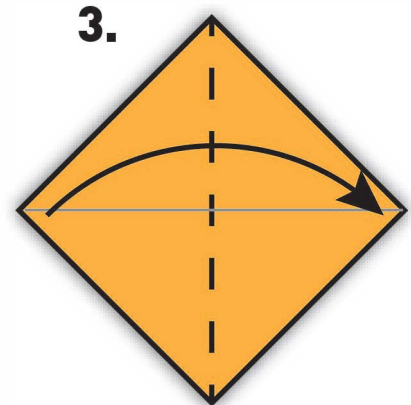
Fold your paper in half along the seam but instead of folding it forward, fold it backwards.



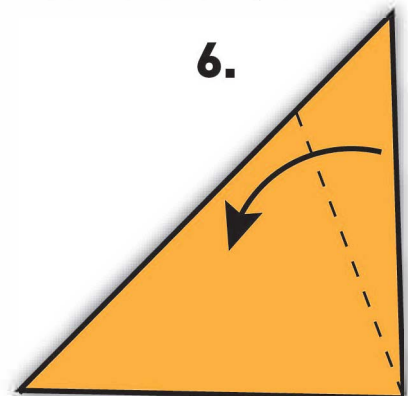
Turn your fox so that the part you just folded is at the top. Now, fold in the other edge.



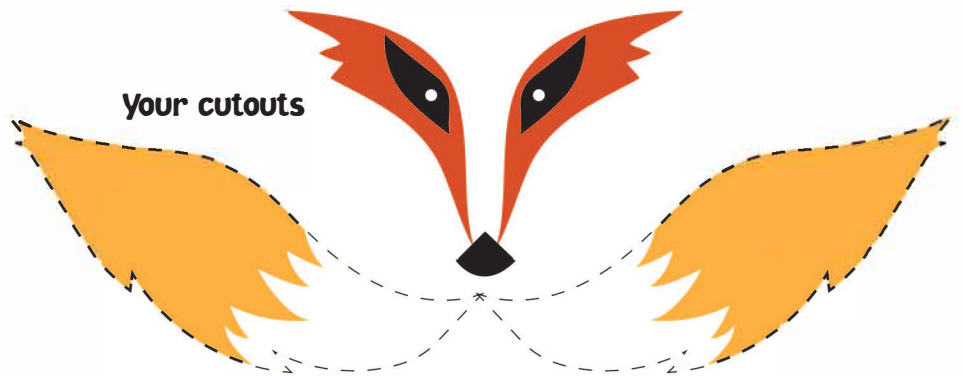
Unfold your paper so it's a diamond, and fold it in half the other way.



On the side that has three edges, fold over two of them on an angle towards the middle.



Glue on the face and tail cut out.



TIP: Use some glue or tape along the inside of the fox's body to help it hold its shape.
